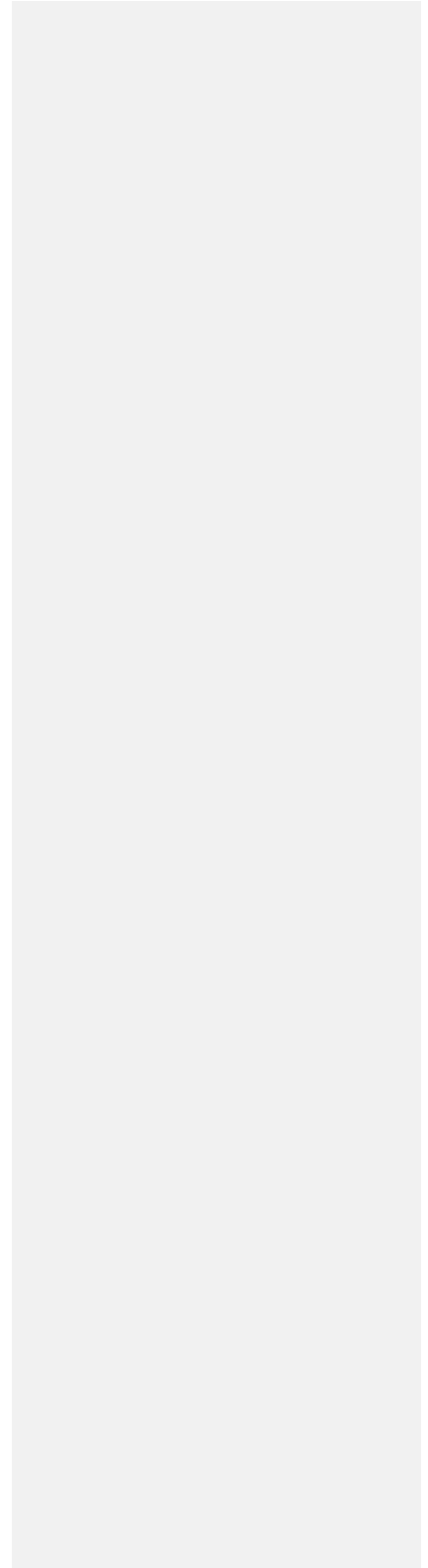

Head Table Seating:

The president officer or meeting chairman must always be seated at the most central seat at the table when there is a central podium, shown as seat number one in the following diagram (figure 1). The principle speaker should occupy seat number two, then other Lion dignitaries in according with the general order of precedence. If possible, there should be the same number of seats to the right and left of the chairman or presiding officer (who would normally be the Club President, District Governor, Council Chairman or International President).

As an example if there is no PID at the head table the seating assignments would be as follows for a District Governor's Official Visitation:

As shown in figure 2, seating at the head table with a podium is essentially the same, except the meeting chairman or presiding officer is always seated at the left of the podium (facing the audience) and the principle speaker at the right.

When spouses are present, they should be seated to the member's left when on the left side of the table, and to the member's right when seated on the right side of the table. When spouses are present at the head table, they should be introduced with the member (e.g. Past International Director John Doe and his wife or (Lion) Jane).

OFFICIAL VISIT OF THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR

Any seating arrangement that puts like officers together will be acceptable and is preferred by the District Governor. DG & KL, VDGs & VPs, DS & CS, DT & CT

Your District Governor is required by Lions Clubs International to make at least one Official Visit to every Club within his District. Usually the Cabinet Secretary & Treasurer will accompany the DG. It is customary for their meals to be as guest of the Club. In most cases, he is the highest-ranking officer of Lions Clubs International to visit the Club during the year. On the occasion of the Official Visit, certain procedures of protocol should be followed.

OFFICIAL VISIT OF THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR

(Continued)

1. **DO NOT** schedule other speakers during the Governor's Official Visit. He will provide the program.
2. Have your attendance committee strive to secure excellent attendance at this meeting.
3. Publicize your Governor's visit.
4. Have your District Governor properly introduced to each Lion and Lioness. Usually, the President or an officer who knows him should do this.
5. Following the opening ceremony and guest introductions: The President will introduce the zone chairperson, who will introduce the rest of the official visitation team.

The following order of Introduction should be used from the Head Table:

Club Treasurer
Club Secretary
Region Chairperson
District Treasurer
District Secretary
Vice District Governor(s)
District Governor

6. Following the meal the zone chairperson will formally introduce the District Governor who will then deliver his/her address.

7. When the Governor is introduced, the Club members should stand and in a like manner should stand at the conclusion of the talk.
8. A brief Board of Directors meeting shall be scheduled following the regular meeting. The president will open the meeting and then immediately turn the meeting over to the District Governor. This is the appropriate time for your members to ask questions and participate in a discussion with the Governor.
9. The District Cabinet Secretary will confer with the Club Secretary to review Membership Reports or answer questions in regard to other reports. The Cabinet Treasurer will confer with the Club Treasurer to review financial reports, etc. and make sure all International and District bills are current.
10. Your District Governor welcomes suggestions for improvements in the administration of the District.

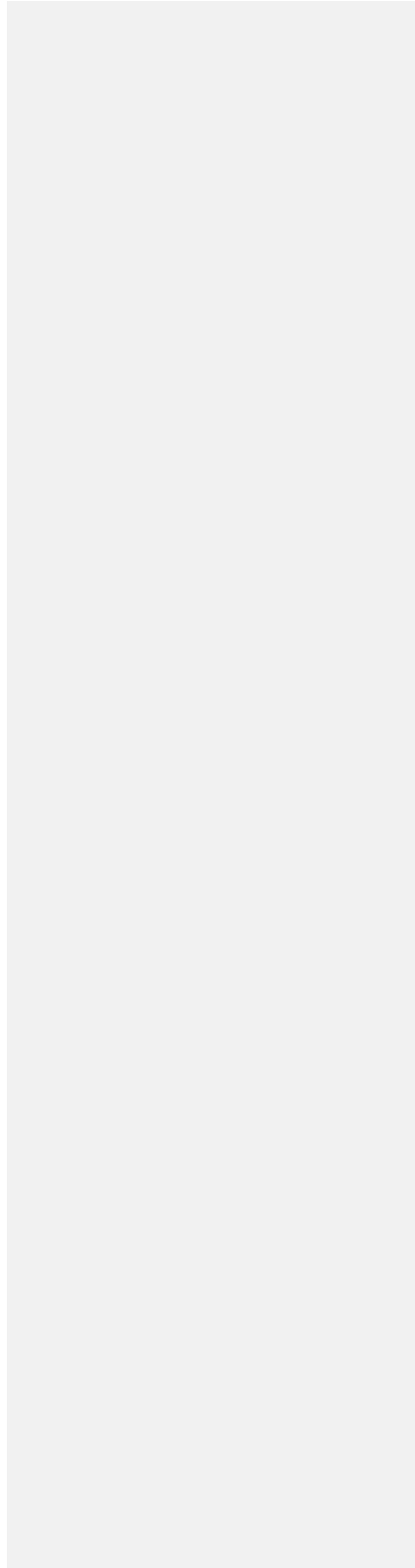

The District Governor's Lions Contest and Awards Program this year is to promote Lion programs and Lionism in our District. Leadership in the clubs will provide the guidance and motivation to promote the clubs community service and Lions activities. All clubs are encouraged to participate in the program. Be proud of your clubs activities and accomplishments. The reward will be worth all effort spent. The District Governor, Vice District Governors, Cabinet Secretary and Cabinet Treasurer shall be the judges for the contests. Judging of the contest will be based on an award criterion. Unless noted contest are from April 1st to March 31st.

The 100% Secretary and 100% Treasurer Awards Shall be from July 1st through June 30th.

The Club President Excellence Award is granted by the International Association of Lions Clubs after the year has been completed, endorsed by the Zone Chairman or the Region Chairman and approved by the District Governor. The Club Secretary must submit the application within (30) **thirty** days following the International Convention.

The categories for the point contest are as follows (based on March 31, 2009 membership):

Group I - Up to 29 members

Group II - 30 to 45 members

Group III - Over 45 members

I. Summer Activities Contest:

A special award will be made to the Lions club, which in the opinion of the District judges performs and completes the most outstanding activity in the District during the summer period from April 1st to August 31st. Each club President must submit to the District Governor no later than March 31st, a written description of the activity which the Board of Directors considers to be their most outstanding summer activity.

II. Delaware State Lions Day:

March 27th will be proclaimed officially as Delaware State Lions Day. Each Lions Club in the District is encouraged to participate in a community activity on that day. An award will be presented at the Sub-District Meeting at the Multiple District Convention to the Lions Club that was judged to have had the most successful project on State Lions Day.

The Lions Club President must submit a written description of the activity to the District Governor no later than March 31, 2009.

III. Achievement Award:

An Achievement Award will be made to the Lions Club in the District that, in the opinion of the District judges produces and completes the most outstanding activity in Delaware during the period from September 1st to March 31st. Each Lions Club President must submit a written description of the activity to the District Governor no later than March 31st.

IV. Membership contest:

Awards will be given to the Lions Club in each category that has the greatest percentage increase in membership during the period April 1st to March 31st according to the membership reports. The District Cabinet Secretary will calculate the percentage based on the March 31, 2009 and 2010 reports.

V. Leo Award:

The award will be a special patch for the Leo Club banner. A Lions Club that sponsors a successful Leo program will be honored at the Multiple District Convention. The Vice District Governor and the District Leo Liaison Chairperson will be the judges for this award.

VI. Visitation:

The purpose of this contest is to encourage the exchange of ideas and fellowship with other Lions in other clubs. This is best accomplished through visitations.

Rules that apply to all visits:

The visiting delegation must consist of:

1. Two (2) Lions from clubs that have 40 or less members as specified in the current roster book.
2. Three (3) Lions from clubs with 41 members or more as specified in the current roster book.
3. Each club visitation in District 22-D can be counted only once in the visitation contest.
4. Visitation team shall give advance notice of Five (5) days to the host club, and shall remain in attendance for the meal and the program.
5. A visitation certificate must be issued, dated and signed by the President or Secretary of the club visited, and then given to the team leader of the visiting delegation.
6. The visitation certificate is given to the Secretary of the home club to be recorded and forwarded to the Cabinet Secretary.
7. The District Governor, Vice District Governors, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer, Region Chairperson, and Zone Chairperson will not be considered as any part of the visitation team when they are attending any club on an Official Visitation.
8. The contest period runs from April 1st to March 31st to be counted including out of state visitations.
9. Visits by individual members to clubs in districts in non-MD-22 states or foreign countries will receive visitation credit. Do not miss an opportunity while on vacation to visit a Lions Club.

An award will be made to each club that visits all (100%) of the Lions Clubs in District 22-D within the contests limits.

(FOR the 100% ADMINISTRATION AWARD ONLY -- ALL IN ZONE and TOTAL of 18 must be completed)

The one Lions Club that makes the most out-of-state visitations in addition to 100% visitation to the Lions Clubs of District 22-D will receive an award.

VII. 100% Club Secretaries Award

Club Membership reports must be postmarked or submitted electronically no later than the last day of each report month. The PU-101 must be submitted by April 30th. Copies of both reports must be submitted to Lions Club International, District Governor or District Secretary, and a copy for the Club files. Club Activity reports will be filed monthly with the District Secretary and annually with LCI

Secretary must attend District 22-D Lions Membership & Leadership Development School, attend the President/Secretary/Treasurer Dinner and be present or represented at 3 Zone meetings.

VIII. 100% Club Treasurers Award

Semiannual International dues paid by due dates (7/21-1/21), and semiannual District dues paid within 30 days after billing date. Payment for District 22-D Pins, Roster Books, and Multiple District Pins must be made within 30 days of receipt. Club should have no outstanding balance with International beyond 60 days. Must report the clubs financial status at all regular club board of director meetings.

Treasurer must attend District 22-D Lions Membership & Leadership Development School, attend the President/Secretary/Treasurer Dinner and be present or represented at 3 Zone meetings.

IX. Club Administrative Awards

The Administrative contest will be conducted similar to the Club President's Excellence Award. **Monthly service activities reports must be completed to be eligible for any Admin Awards** There are (6) areas identified: Membership, Communications, Visitations, Dues, Leadership, and Attendance. There will be awards given to all clubs that accomplish the "Required" goals and the designated number of "Optional" goals for each area. All clubs that meet the requirements for all 6 areas will be awarded a 100% club.

Contest period April 1st to March 31st. The CS must receive all reports by April 15, 2009.

As shown on the form there are required activities and several optional ones that will allow the club to pick how it chooses to attain the goals. A Club needs to complete each goal only once during the year with following exceptions: Membership Report submitted, Membership Report read to club, Lions Information read at meetings, and Submission of activities reports, which are monthly. Attendance at Zone Meetings, which should be 3 times, and payment of the International and District dues, which is twice a year.

The District Governor will have the final decision on any questions, discrepancies, or changes to the contest and awards program.

X. Activities Award

Based on the Monthly District Activities Report, clubs will be competing for recognition in their Group in the following areas: Sight Services, Hearing Services, Environment, Youth Services, Community Services, Diabetes Awareness and Education, International Relations, Health Services, and over all Service. Contest period April 1st to March 31st. CS must receive all reports by April 30th. Banner Patches will be awarded at the Multiple District Convention for the Club that has the most documented activity in their Group in each of the areas listed above. Instructions are supplied with the forms.

XI. Bulletin Editor's Award

The purpose of this award is to encourage each Lions Clubs to improve its dissemination of local club, District, Multiple District, and Lions International information to its members.

- A. Club Bulletins shall have the following contents:
- A resume of the last dinner and director's meeting.
 - Announcement of planned programs.
 - Committee reports and club activities.
 - District events (Include DG's letter from Dist. Bulletin if the District Bulletin is not distributed to all members) and information from LCI.
 - Items from other clubs in zone and region.
 - Short personal items about new members.
 - Items of interest to club members.

- Complete roster of membership, including address and telephone numbers at least twice a year.
 - Complete list of officers and committee chairpersons at least twice a year.
- B. Rules:
1. The editor must be a member of the Lions Club.
 2. Contest period is from July 1st to March 31st.
 3. **Important:** Bulletins must be published regularly, at least once a month. Copies of each must be sent to the District Governor, Vice District Governor, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer, Region Chairperson, the club's Zone Chairperson, and District Bulletin Editor. It is also requested that you include the District Public Relations Chairperson.
- C. Award
- The winner will be announced at the District Convention Sub-District Meeting. The District Governor assisted by the Region Chairpersons will judge bulletins. Judging will be based on neatness, ingenuity, interest, and regularity of publications

XII. CLUB SCRAPBOOK CONTEST

The purpose of the Club scrapbook contest is to promote and give exposure to the activities of the Lions Clubs and Lioness Clubs within our Multiple District and to provide new ideas and stimulation for the members of other clubs. It will enable clubs to portray with a sense of pride various ways and means used by them in serving their communities.

Scrapbooks should be submitted to the District Governor by April 27th. This is 3 weeks in advance of the opening of the MD-22 convention. District judging will be completed two weeks before the Convention.

To facilitate thorough and fair judging all scrapbooks submitted for judging must be formatted according to the judging criteria. That is, there should be separate tabbed sections for introduction, Club meetings, District and International Meetings, Fund Raising Activities and Projects, Community Service Activities and Projects, and Advertising Lionism.

Judging Criteria:

- Originality and Creativeness
- Attractiveness and neatness
- Clear and informative descriptions and captions
- Display of a variety of photographs, souvenirs, news articles, etc.
- Smooth and easy-to-follow flow of ideas, information and/or theme
- Completeness and appropriateness of content
- Projection of a positive club image
- Overall high quality of information/pages (versus quantity)

Judging Categories:

1. **Cover** – Should include Lions logo, name of club, and Lion Year (2009 –2010)
0-5 Points
2. **Introduction** – Should include Title Page, Table of Contents, Club Information, List of Committees, and List of Officers. **0-5 Points**
3. **Club Meetings** (Regular and Special) – Should include Information about such events as meeting programs, Speakers, special club meeting events, awards presented at meetings etc.**0-20 Points**
4. **District and International Meetings and Conventions** – Should include information about the club's involvement in District and/or International events, such as District meetings and Socials, Regional and/or Zone Advisory Meetings, USA/Canada Leadership Forum, International and Multiple District 22 Conventions, Sight and Hearing Meetings, Etc.. **0-10 Points**
5. **Fund Raising Activities and Projects** – Should include list of all fund raising activities and description/display about each of these activities and projects
0-25 Points
6. **Community Service Activities and Projects** – Should include information about club service events such as health fairs and eye screening, awarding of scholarships, SWAT highway clean-up, youth and/or school activities (to include Leos), distributing food baskets, assisting local citizens, club participation in community-sponsored projects (e.g. parades or festivals), club sight and hearing assistance, etc.. **0-25 Points**
7. **Advertising Lionism** – Should include information that advertises Lionism and your club in general, such as club bulletins/newsletters, club web site, club ads in local school yearbooks, sports program books, calendars, newspapers, District Social Program Book, etc **0-10 Points**

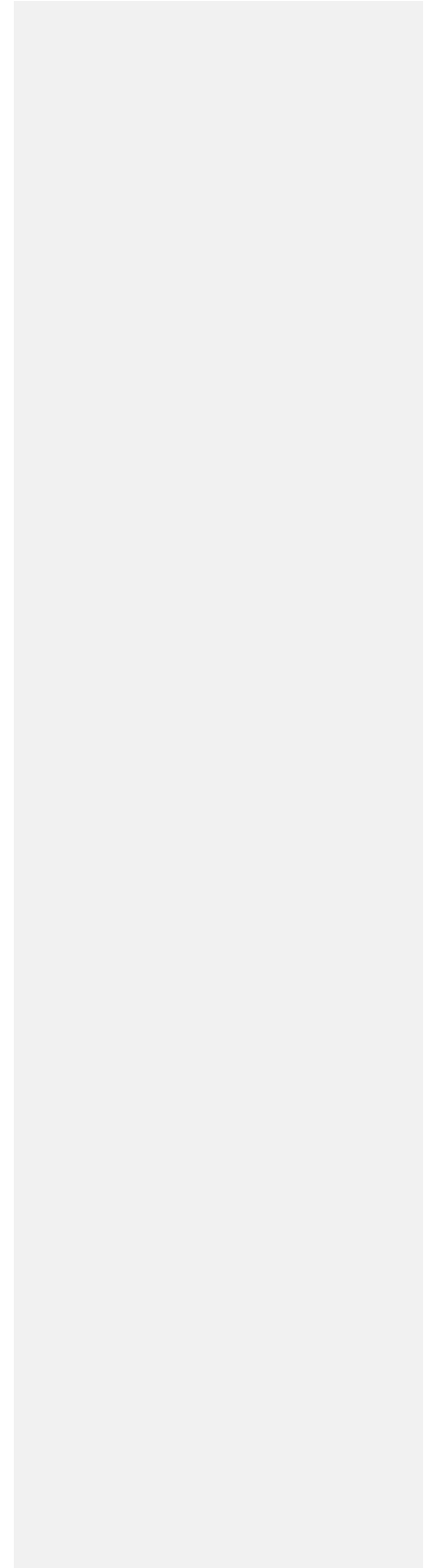

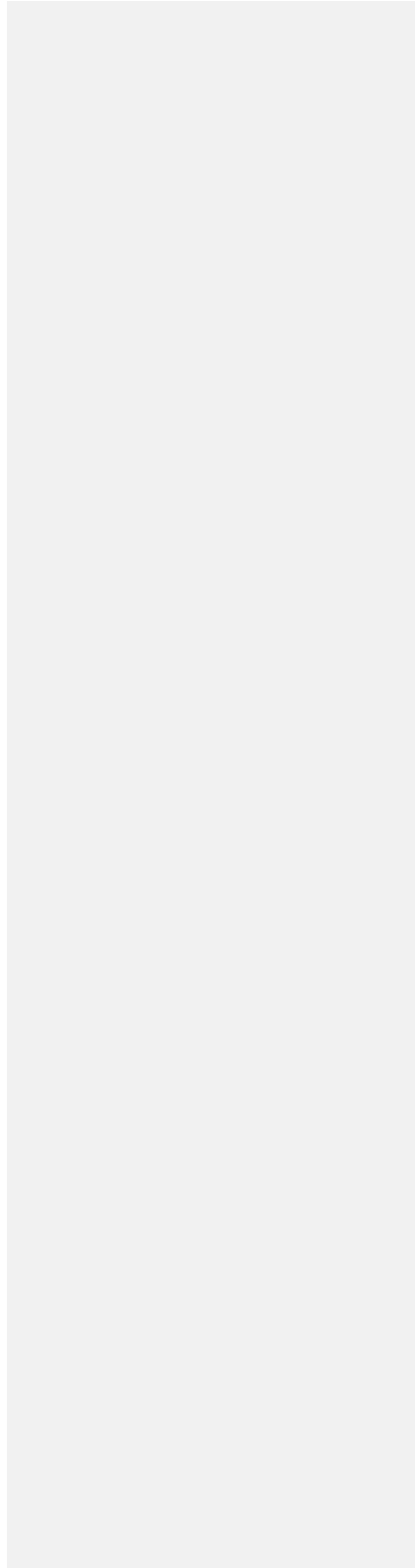
