Directions to the Dewey Beach Lions Club House:

From the north:

Take SR1 south. As you enter Dewey Beach the speed limit will drop to 30MPH. As you pass the Bottle & Cork move into the right lane. The first street after the B&C is Dagsworthy Street, the next street is McKinley Avenue (the street sign is missing). Turn right on McKinley. At the end of the block you will see the DBLC playground on the right. Turn right immediately after the playground and drive forward into the clubhouse parking lot.

From the south:

Take SR1 north. As you enter Dewey Beach the speed limit will drop to 30MPH. Stay in the left lane and watch for the Bottle & Cork. As you pass the B&C move into the left turn lane at the Bellevue Street traffic signal. Make a U-turn and move into the right lane. The first street after the B&C is Dagsworthy Street, The next street is McKinley Avenue (the street sign is missing). Turn right on McKinley. At the end of the block you will see the DBLC playground on the right. Turn right immediately after the playground and drive forward into the clubhouse parking lot.
